

Searching for Prior Executions

Searching is most successful when using the "Name" field to search the name of the job you would like to find. The rest of the filters likely aren't going to be of much help. From there, you can look

through the job executions to find the one you were looking for.

NOTE: There is currently no way to search by options (variables) passed.
